Your sources of inspiration at work ?

'Experience teaches several lessons' - the best lesson so far you learnt ?

Not to take anything easy at work, being alert every moment, to be dare enough to express the defects found.

What do you do for the allround development of the students ?

I put in all my efforts in academic as well as cultural aspects of the students. And I prefer to take up every new project and idea that comes along..... try to implement first in our school... and prove the school to be the best in it. While doing so, naturally, I can cater to the allround development of the students.

How do you mould your child to become a good citizen ?

I always try to induce inner discipline that leads the students towards a right path.

What's the need to categorise students into A1, A2 and A3 ? Won't it effect their confidence ?

'Grading' is to analyse the students as per their I.Q and to impart education according to their mental capabilities. Thereby students of all categories feel comfortable in learning and especially the slow learners never get depressed and in turn become more competitive.

Slow learners - what are the remedial measures you suggest ?

Firstly we identify the slow learners and find out the root - cause and then adapt suitable methods for their improvement. For example: If a student is slow in noting down from the blackboard, we first try to know whether the child has eyesight problem or something related to his interest. If it is due to poor eyesight, we advise him to see the doctor and if it is lack of interest, we create an atmosphere that induces interest in him by using audio visual-aids and play-way methods. And if the cause is concerned with laziness, only stern discipline will turn him right.

Your message to the students ?

School sets a stage for the students to get an opportunity to rehearse all the activities and build up into an allrounder. Take it as a good chance to participate in all the extra-curricular activities besides

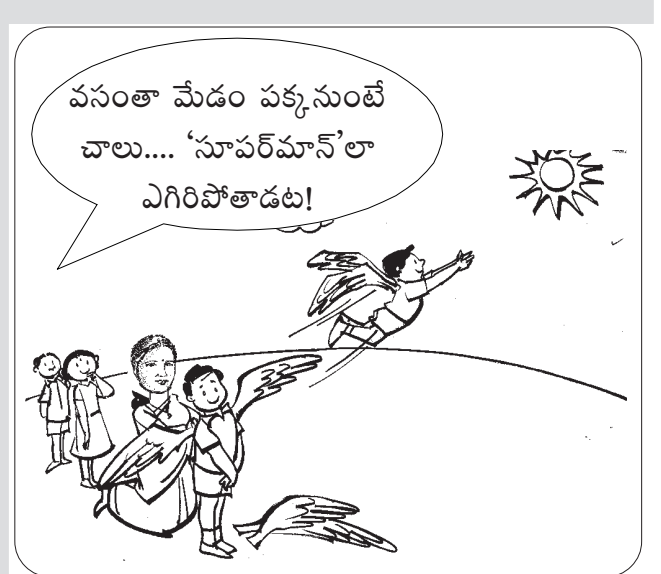
Your appeal to the parents ?
